The 12th-ranked Tiger men's basketball team split games last weekend, losing to Depauw to snap a 15-game winning streak, but then erased a 15-point deficit in the final 4:41 of the game to beat Centre 58-56 on a last-second basket.

Charles Houston, in addition to hitting the game-winning shot against Centre, eclipsed 500 career rebounds in the game, finishing with 14 points and 12 boards. Nick Polidoroff and Jonathan Lewis also reached career rebounding milestones, grabbing their 300th and 200th, respectively.

Since joining the SCAC in 1991-92, Houston is only the fourth Trinity player to reach 500 career rebounds, and the first since Peter Murray and Sean Devins (both 2001-05).

Houston is also three steals from breaking his own single season record of 57 steals in one year, which he set in 2006-07. With just 12 more steals, he can break the career record of 173, set by Jason Morris from 2001-05.

B.J. Moon that sparked the Tigers to the win on Saturday, scoring 13 of his 18 points in the final five minutes of the game. His four-point play with 2:26 remaining cut an eight-point deficit in half, putting Trinity in position to complete the comeback.

Moon is five assists from passing Andy Bates for 14th on Trinity's all-time list, and is also 12 assists from reaching 200 in his career. He is also 10 steals from becoming the eighth player in school history to reach 100 in his career.

Patrick Robinson is tied with Mike Mataya (1996-2000) with 94 three-pointers made in his career, needing six more to become the 13th player in Trinity history to reach 100 career threes.

Trinity will face off against the University of Dallas on Tuesday night, having won 13 consecutive games in the series. The Tigers have also won 18 of the past 19 meetings, and stand 24-3 against Dallas since 1986-87. The last loss came in 1994-95, when Dallas won 58-56 in Irving, Texas. The Tigers won 80-70 in San Antonio last season.
