11/29	Whitman College	W 71-61	Charles Houston, recently named SCAC Defensive Player of the Year for the second consecutive season, is Trinity's record-holder in single season and career steals. He is also in the top 10 in career rebounds, needing 27 more to become the fifth player to pull down 600 rebounds in a career.

At Stevens Point, Wisconsin, Trinity defeated Hanover 73-65 before losing a 61-55 game to hosting UWSP. Peter Murray averaged 16 points and 7.0 rebounds per game during the playoffs to lead Trinity.
