Game Notes

The 17th-ranked Trinity Tiger men's basketball team will host the 22nd-ranked UT-Dallas Comets in a second round playoff game tonight in Sams Gymnasium. The two teams last met in the playoffs during the 2004-05 season, with Trinity taking a 72-66 win in the first round. Trinity holds a 3-0 record over UT-Dallas overall, winning 66-54 in 2001-02 and 64-45 the next season.

UT-Dallas is playing in just its second NCAA Tournament, qualifying for this year's tournament by winning the American Southwest Conference Championship. The Comets defeated Mississippi College 82-75 in the title game last Sunday.

B.J. Moon has now moved up to 24th in school history in points scored, needing 67 more to become the 23rd player in school history to reach 1,000 points in a career. Charles Houston is now 27th in career scoring at Trinity, and can reach 900 with 49 more points.

Houston is also in the top 10 in rebounding at Trinity, standing 20 boards away from reaching 600 in his career - a milestone reached by only four other players in school history.

Moon is also seventh in career three-point field goals, needing three more to pass Chad Stroberg (2001-05) on the list. Moon could also pass current assistant coach Ross Burt (2002-06) with five more long-range field goals.

Houston's 21 points on Thursday marked the sixth time a Tiger player has scored 20 or more in a Division III playoff game. The record is a 27-point game from Jason Morris, who did so in a 2004 loss to Sul Ross.

Luke Caldarera's 10 rebounds against Maryville (TN) marked just the fifth time in the playoffs that Trinity has had a player grab 10 or more rebounds. Only two other players have done so - Sean Devins did it three times in 2004 and 2005, while Peter Murray had a 10-rebound game against Pomona in 2005.

Trinity's 24 wins this season are tied for the second-most in school history. In 2003-04, the Tigers were 24-5 overall to set the new record for wins. The very next season, the team went 3-1 in the NCAA Playoffs to finish 25-7 and set the record that still stands today.
