The 10th-ranked Trinity Tiger men opened up a weekend of play in the SCAC with a 55-40 win over Sewanee: University of the South on Friday night.

B.J. Moon led the team with 16 points, hitting 4-5 from three-point range, and 6-7 overall from the floor. Dwight Lutz came off the bench to score a career-high 15 points, nailing 6-10 field goals and 3-6 three-point tries. Lutz also added a pair of rebounds and a pair of assists in his 23 minutes of work.

Charles Houston continues to close in on 500 career rebounds, and is now 11 boards from tying Wyatt McVea (1978-80) for 11th on the all-time list. Peter Murray and Sean Devins (2001-05) are the last players to reach the milestone, and only one other – Quintin Mason (1997-2001) – has done so in the last 20 years.

Moon's four three-pointers in Friday's game put him within one of tying Mike Cleary (1995-99) for seventh place in school history. He is 27 three-point field goals from tying current Trinity assistant coach Ross Burt (2002-06) for fifth place all-time. Patrick Robinson is eight three-pointers away from becoming the 13th player at Trinity to record 100 or more three-point field goals.

Houston is 16 steals from tying Jason Morris (2001-05) for the career steals record of 173. With his three steals on Friday, he joined Morris as the only players to record 50 or more steals in more than one season. Houston, who has exactly 50 steals this season, holds the single season record with 57 in 2006-07.

B.J. Moon is looking to be the first Tiger player since 2005 (Morris, Chad Stroberg) to collect 200 career assists. Moon has 183 assists to his credit so far in his career, and will next pass Peter Murray (2001-05) and Andy Bates (2002-06).

Last season against Oglethorpe, the Tigers lost 65-70 on the road, despite a solid double-double from Houston. He finished with 16 points and 10 rebounds, while Moon led the team with 17 points and three assists.
