Men's Soccer vs. Sewanee

The Tiger men's soccer team, ranked as high as sixth nationally, opened up a weekend of SCAC play with a 3-0 road win over Oglethorpe on Friday.

Neither team scored in the first half, but Trinity held a 7-0 lead in shots taken. The Tigers finally started making those shots count in the second half, beginning with a goal in the 48th minute by Andrew Chong.

After Chong hit his eventual game-winning goal, Trinity then added two more goals in the half to take the 3-0 win. Alan Llobet and Clay Middleton scored for the Tigers.

Trinity heads to Sewanee on Sunday afternoon, finishing off the weekend. Trinity defeated Sewanee 5-1 in San Antonio last year, and also won 5-1 in the last meeting at Sewanee, Tennessee.

Llobet's goal on Friday was his fourth of the season, tying him for second on the team - despite being a defender. Llobet and the Trinity defense have also recorded 10 shutouts this season - including five against SCAC opponents.

Chong and Middleton both hit their first goals this season, becoming the 11th and 12th players to score goals for the Tigers this season.
