YELLOW = Plastics

Empty plastic containers labeled #1 through #7

⊘ No food, liquids, Styrofoam, or shopping bags ⊘

BLUE = Aluminum

Empty aluminum, steel and tin containers

⊘ No food or liquids ⊘

GREEN = Office Paper

High grade white paper, such as letterhead, printer paper and copier paper

⊘ No colored paper, file folders, mixed paper, or wet paper ⊘

WHITE = Mixed Paper

Most clean and dry types of paper, such as white and colored paper, junk mail, newspapers, file folders, catalogs, magazines, paperback books, paper bags, carbonless paper, cereal and other dry food boxes (with liners removed)

⊘ No tissue products, food wrap, or wet paper ⊘

GRAY = Trash/Waste

Non-recyclable solid waste, such as tissue products, food wrap, or wet paper, and items not accepted in other receptacles, such as glass or shopping bags

CARDBOARD BOXES

Break down cardboard boxes and place along wall at recycling center; collapsed boxes may also be left in the corridor for pick-up if clearly labeled as recycling
